#### Page 8:

- Minatour's kaolin deposit near Streaky Bay, which is of very high quality with 9 million tonne plus **220 million tonne** inferred, and is selling for \$US500/tonne **when calcined**. Starting 2008/9. **The company intends to build a treatment plant on Eyre Peninsula based on outcomes of a feasibility study.**
- **Iluka Resources has indicated massive deposits of high grade mineral sands from their Jacinth-Ambrosia project will be exported from a port near Ceduna. They are on schedule to commence mining in 2010 with full production of 300,000 tonnes per year of zircon in 2011.** Product is going to the company's West Australian plant for treatment that with planning, could be done on site.
