



The Bingara Accord

The parties wish to pursue national prosperity through real economic improvements to important regional roads.

The parties agree:

- to seek to bring roads into line with the mainstream practices of Australia's infrastructure sectors;
- to employ 'user pays-user gets' trials for road improvements to test this
 approach in the interests of helping rural commodities move cheaper
 under safe conditions;
- 3. that the Australian Rural Roads Group asset and investment template is appropriate for local roads throughout regional Australia; and
- 4. that submissions should be made to include suitably aggregated proposals in Infrastructure Australia's national infrastructure audit and infrastructure priorities list.
